A Note from the Executive Director

I am pleased to share that we had our initial inspection on March 3rd for our Assisted Living licensure and anticipate a return visit within 90 days. In the upcoming weeks, administrative staff will begin reaching out to each of you to sign an updated contract that reflects the shift to service levels as well as new language reflecting Assisted Living verbiage and structure.

Other excitement inside the community was the opening of the new hair salon & barbershop located on the second floor near the library. Everyone seems to be enjoying it so far!

The majority of our residents are now fully-vaccinated, which allows for more visitation and a sense of normalcy. The next vaccine clinic is on April 6th and many more residents will receive their second dose. Many residents in our Memory Care area had received an infusion in January, making them ineligible for the vaccine until April 6th. Due to this, the Connections Neighborhood visitation will be slightly different than the rest of the community.

This past year has certainly presented its challenges. Now we are seeing the light at the end of the tunnel and the future looks bright. Community Life programming is becoming more vibrant as we are able to hold larger group events and invite entertainers back.
